An eco-consciousness in baths and kitchens surfaces at the furniture fair and design week in New York

Effeti USA introduced its new BK1 and BK2 kitchens by architects Gabriele and Oscar Buratti. They were on display in the Terminal Stores building, where the Wanted Design showcase was also held. Made in Florence, Italy, the kitchens are both beautiful and sustainable. With BK2, the minimal aesthetic is used to maximum effect. Sleek lines and bright lacquered interior shelves are covered by textured oak doors finished in a matte lacquer. The peninsula table is done in a thermo-treated chestnut. BK1 features a solid-steel fireplace that can be used for cooking.
